

FORM ES7: EDUCATIONAL SUPERVISORS GRANT

CLAIM FORM 2010/11

Criteria

GP Trainers are entitled to claim a grant for providing educational supervision for GP Registrars in lieu of a trainers grant. Educational supervision grants are only applicable when a trainee is being clinical supervised in another practice or hospital placement. A trainer (or the training practice) cannot claim both an educational supervisors grant and a trainers grant for the same period of time. The educational contract outlining the responsibilities of the Deanery, GP trainer and trainee is to be signed within the RCGP e-portfolio. Quality of educational reviews is to be monitored by the deanery and payment will be withheld if there are concerns about the quality of educational supervision reports.

Please note all payments will be made to the training practice as a training provider and not to individual trainers. Claims to be made within 3 months of the last review. Deadline for all claims for 2010/11 financial year is 31st January 2011.
